

International Keyboard Driver Installation Instructions

- Create a new directory
 \wince4x0\public\common\oak\drivers\keybdint\international
- Unzip KBDINT.ZIP in this directory
- Open the menu "File/Manage Catalog Features" and import
 "KBD_International.cec"
- In the Catalog Window open the tree "Catalog/Device
 Drivers/Input/Devices/Keyboard/Mouse"
- Mark "8042 Keyboard/Mouse International" for standard keyboards or "NOP
 (Stub) Keyboard/Mouse International" for USB keyboards
- Drag the selected driver to the FeatureView of your project and drop it
- Insert the marked lines in PLATFORM.BIB into the existing PLATFORM.BIB in
 your platform directory. This will avoid "duplicate file" errors (4.0) / warnings.
- Start the menu item "Build/Rebuild Platform" to create a new WindowsCE image

Updating the Keyboard Driver from previous versions:

In case you have already installed an older version than 1.2 you need to update the CEC component

- Unzip KBDINT.ZIP in the directory
 \wince4x0\public\common\oak\drivers\keybdint\international
- In the Feature View, select "Device Drivers/Input Devices/8042
 Keyboard/Mouse International". Open the context menu with the right mouse
 button and select "Delete".
- Open the menu "File/Manage Catalog Features". Mark "kbd_international.cec
 and press the "Remove" button.
- Press the "Import" button and select the updated kbd_international.cec
- Remove the reference to KEYBDPNL.CPL in
 \wince4x0\platform\%_TGTPLAT%\files\PLATFORM.BIB
- Insert the marked lines in PLATFORM.BIB into the existing PLATFORM.BIB in
 your platform directory. This will avoid "duplicate file" errors (4.0) / warnings.
- Recompile the code with "Rebuild Platform"
